## **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

The request for waiver of Import Duties, GETFund Levy, NHIL, Import VAT, Import VAT, EXIM Levy, Special Import Levy and other domestic taxes including VAT, amounting to the Ghana Cedi equivalent of ***Five Million, Three Hundred and Fifty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred and Eighty-Seven United States Dollars and Five Cents (US\$5,358,987.05)*** on imports [amounting to US\$4,239,854.00] and local purchases [amounting to US\$1,119,133.05] of materials, equipment and

services required for the Construction, Supply and Installation of Educational Equipment and Training to **Ten (10) Regional Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics (STEAM) Centers** was *presented* to the House on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 by the Honourable Minister responsible for Planning, Professor George Yaw Gyan-Baffour on behalf of the Minister responsible for Finance.

Pursuant to Order 169 of the Standing Orders of the House, the Request was *referred* to the Finance Committee for consideration and report.

The Committee met and considered the request with the Minister for Education, Hon. Dr. Matthew Opoku Prempeh, a Deputy Minister for Finance, Hon. Abena Osei-Asare and a team of officials from the Ministries of Finance and Education as well as the Ghana Revenue Authority (GRA) and hereby presents this report to the House pursuant to order 161(1) of the Standing Orders of the House.

## **2.0 BACKGROUND**

The Government of Ghana has endeavoured to expand access to basic education for all children through programmes such as Education for all (EFA) and the Free Compulsory Universal Basic Education (FCUBE). Some progress has been made with enrolments increasing substantially through the introduction of

programmes such as the capitation grant, school feeding , free school uniform and free text and exercise books programmes.

Despite increased enrolment, the quality of education in the basic schools continues to be a source of concern to the Ministry of Education and Ghana as a whole.

Student's performance in the Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study over the years has shown weaknesses in investigative work, practical activities, ability to comprehend and solve higher order questions among others.

The problem is exacerbated by a lack of a strategic approach to science and mathematics education and poor facilities generally.

To improve the quality of Science and Mathematics education in Ghana, Government intends to introduce Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics (STEAM) education and provide STEAM Centres with science and maths's equipment.

STEAM education integrates concepts that are usually taught as separate subjects and emphasizes the application of knowledge to real life situations and also finding solution to a real world problem and can be seen as integrating knowledge across different disciplines. Research has shown that the best practice in early childhood education is to break away from passive instruction and allow for more play and investigation, and this kind of learning early in life builds skills and interests that serve children better.

The Centres will offer a variety of selected interactive learning environments with a large range of topics including science and technology, mathematics, engineering, graphic design, digital music, robotics, computer technologies, etc.

### **3.0 TOTAL WAIVER REQUESTED**

The total amount of taxes and duties for which waiver is being sought is the Ghana Cedi equivalent of ***Five Million, Three Hundred and Fifty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred and Eighty-Seven United States Dollars and Five Cents (US\$5,358,987.05).***

### **4.0 OBSERVATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

#### **4.1 Parliamentary Approval of Project**

Parliament at its Fourteenth Sitting of the Second Meeting held on Thursday, 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2019, approved by resolution the Contract Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Ghana (represented by the Ministry of Education) and ROBO Group T.E.K. Limited of Israel for an amount of Eighty-Eight Million, Seven Hundred and Ninety-Five Thousand, Six Hundred and Forty-Five Ghana Cedis (GH¢88,795,645.00) for the Construction, Supply and Installation of Educational Equipment and Training to Ten (10)

Regional Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics (STEAM) Centres.

## **4.2 Project Objectives**

The Committee noted that the objectives of the project are to:

- establish the foundation of improving the pedagogy of teaching of Basic Science and Mathematics education in 10 regions nationwide;
- increase the accessibility of modern teaching methods within science and mathematics education to all Basic Science and Mathematics instructors and learners;
- promote the importance of Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics (STEAM) education in an increasingly technological world;
- equip STEAM Centre instructors with the skills to support students with Educational Needs;
- provide ICT equipment to improve the Competency of both instructors and learners; and
- introduce basic programming to learners of all ages, ensure that cognitive and motor skills are developed as they work through activities that stimulate creativity, curiosity and problem-solving abilities.

### **4.3 Need for Waiver**

The Committee noted that under Section II (D), Clause 44.3 of the *General Conditions* of the Contract Agreement signed between the Government of the Republic of Ghana represented by the Ministry of Education and the Robo T.E.K. Group Limited, the Government of Ghana has committed to exempt the contractor from the payment of taxes, duties, levies and other compulsory charges in Ghana under Ghanaian Law.

Consequently, it was explained to the Committee that the Government of Ghana is fully responsible for the component of the project financing cost covering taxes and other fiscal levies which may be imposed in the Republic of Ghana with respect to the supply and purchase of materials, equipment and services required for the execution of the project.

### **4.4 Benefits of the Project**

The Committee observed that the project when implemented is expected to produce highly skilled human capital through improvement in the proficiency of instructors and students by enhancing their cognitive and motor skills as well as problem-solving abilities.

## **5.0 CONCLUSION**

The Committee is satisfied that the request is in consonance with the Contract Agreement between the Government of the Republic

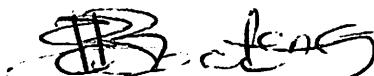
of Ghana represented by the Ministry of Education and the Robo T.E.K. Group Limited for the implementation of the Project.

The Committee therefore recommends to the House to adopt this report and *approve by resolution*, the **request for waiver of Import Duties, GETFund Levy, NHIL, Import VAT, Import VAT, EXIM Levy, Special Import Levy and other domestic taxes including VAT**, amounting to the Ghana Cedi equivalent of **Five Million, Three Hundred and Fifty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred and Eighty-Seven United States Dollars and Five Cents (US\$5,358,987.05)** on imports [amounting to US\$4,239,854.00] and local purchases [amounting to US\$1,119,133.05] of materials, equipment and services required for the Construction, Supply and Installation of Educational Equipment and Training to **Ten (10) Regional Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics (STEAM) Centers** in accordance with Article 174(2) of the 1992 Constitution of the Republic of Ghana.

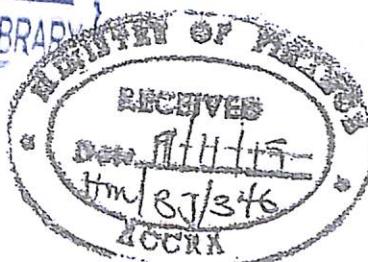

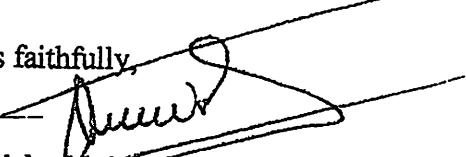
