### IN THE FOURTH SESSION OF THE SEVENTH PARLIAMENT OF THE FOURTH REPUBLIC OF GHANA

# REPORT OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE ON THE EXPENDITURE IN ADVANCE OF APPROPRIATION FOR JANUARY TO MARCH 2021

#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

The **Expenditure** in **Advance** of **Appropriation** for **January** to **March 2021** was laid in the House on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 and *referred* to the Finance Committee for consideration and report pursuant to Article 180 of the 1992 Constitution and the Standing Orders of the House.

To consider the referral, the Committee met with the Minister for Finance, Hon. Ken Ofori-Atta and his Deputies Hon. Kwaku Kwarteng, Hon. Abena Osei-Asare and Hon. Charles Adu Boahen as well as the Chief Director and other officials from the Ministry of Finance. Also in attendance was the Controller and Accountant-General, Mr. Kwasi Kwaning-Bosompem.



The Committee is grateful to the Hon. Minister for Finance, the Hon. Deputy Ministers for Finance, the Chief Director and the other officials of the Ministry of Finance for attending upon the Committee. The Committee is equally grateful to the Controller and Accountant General for attending upon the Committee.

#### 2.0 REFERENCES

The Committee referred to and/or was guided by the following documents in its deliberations on the Expenditure in Advance of Appropriation for the 2021 Financial Year:

- The 1992 Constitution of the Republic of Ghana
- Estimates of the Revenues and Expenditure of the Government of Ghana for the 2021 financial year
- The Standing Orders of the House
- The Public Financial Management Act, 2016 (Act 921)

#### 3.0 BACKGROUND

The 1992 Constitution of the Republic of Ghana provides in Article 180 that "where it appears to the President that the Appropriation Act in respect of any financial year will not come into operation by the beginning of that financial year, he may, with the prior approval of Parliament by a resolution, authorise the withdrawal of moneys from the Consolidated Fund for the purpose of meeting expenditure necessary to carry on the services of the Government in respect of the

period expiring three months from the beginning of the financial year or on the coming into operation of the Act whichever is earlier"

Also, Section 23 of the Public Financial management Act, 2016 (Act 921 provides that

"Where the President is satisfied that the Appropriation Act in respect of a financial year, will not come into operation at the beginning of that financial year, the President may, with the prior approval of Parliament, by

- (a) resolution in accordance with article 180 of the Constitution, and
- (b) warrant addressed to the Minister, authorise the issue of moneys from the Consolidated Fund for purposes of meeting the expenditure necessary to carry on the services of the Government, until the expiration of three months from the beginning of that financial year, or from the coming into operation of the Appropriation Act, whichever is earlier."

The **Expenditure in Advance of Appropriation for January to March 2021** therefore shows the amount Government would require out of the Consolidated Fund to meet expenditure on public services until the 2021 Annual Estimates are considered and approved by Parliament.

### 4.0 TOTAL AMOUNT OF EXPENDITURE IN ADVANCE OF APPROPRIATION

The total amount of money required for government expenditure for the first quarter of 2021 in advance of appropriation is *Twenty-Seven Billion, Four Hundred and Thirty-Four Million, One Hundred and Eighty Thousand, Five Hundred and Twenty Ghana Cedis* (GH¢27,434,180,520.)

The anticipated expenditure to be covered under this vote is as summarised in the table below:

#### 4.1 2021 FIRST OUARTER MACROECONOMIC PROJECTIONS

Total revenue and grants for the First Quarter of 2021 is projected to amount to GH¢13,340,253,500 (equivalent to 3.0 percent of GDP)

Total tax revenue for the period of January to March 2021 is expected to amount to GH¢10,427,753,843 whilst non-tax revenue is expected to reach GH¢1,916,561,037.

Total expenditure for the first quarter of 2021 is projected at GH¢23,664,596,915 representing 5.3 percent of GDP. Of this amount capital expenditure for the period is estimated at GH¢1,903,658,408.

Total Budget for the first quarter contains an overall deficit balance of GH¢10,674,343,415 representing 2.4 percent of GDP. This deficit is the excess of projected expenditure over revenue for the first quarter of 2021.

#### 5.0 OBSERVATIONS

#### 5.1 No *virement* without Approval from the Ministry of Finance

The Committee observed that the Controller and Accountant General has been instructed to ensure that all Ministries, Departments and Agencies operate strictly within the levels set in the expenditure in advance of appropriation and under no circumstances should funds be *vired* from the Compensation of Employees to cover expenditure items

for goods and services or capital expenditure except with prior approval from the Ministry of Finance.

The Committee also noted that it would not be permitted for votes provided in the Estimates to be used to defray indebtedness carried over from the 2020 financial year, except as provided for in the Estimates.

#### **5.2 Basic Assumption**

The Committee was informed that the figures contained in the Expenditure in Advance of Appropriation were based on the assumption of "no new policy changes" for the first quarter of 2021.

#### 5.3 Wage Bill Projections

The committee sought to know how the *Compensation of Employees* figure for the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2021 was arrived at.

To this, the Committee was informed that the figure of GH¢7,708,960,148 was arrived at on the assumption that the wage bill will grow by an estimated 8 percent for the 2021 financial year.

The Committee was further informed that within the context of the COVID-19 "burden sharing", Government employees should expect a somewhat restricted increase in their remuneration.

It was further explained that Government is doing its best to ensure that workers do not suffer reductions in their wages and salaries as is being experienced in other jurisdictions.

#### 5.4 Other expenditure

As to what constituted "Other Expenditure" for which GH¢813,610,025 has been allocated for January to March 2021, the Committee was informed that this comprises ESLA Transfers of GH¢388,630,791 and COVID-related expenditures of GH¢424,979,233.

The COVID-related expenditure include the provision of Health Infrastructure (GH¢171,741,733), Seed Fund for Capitalization of a Development Bank (GH¢78,237,500) and the cost of the Economic Revitalization Programme (GH¢175 Million).

#### 5.5 Use of Goods and Services

The Committee noted that an amount of GH¢1,595,571,683 has been allocated towards the Use of Goods and Services.

The Committee was informed that this amount will be applied towards the Free Senior High School, School Feeding, Capitation Grant, Nation

Builders Corp (NABCO), Livelihood Empowerment Against Poverty (LEAP) Programmes and Security.

#### **5.6 Pensions Calculations**

The Committee noted that His Excellency the President recently assured workers publicly that the Social Security and National Insurance Trust (SSNIT) "past credit" issue relating to the computation of workers' pension benefits would be addressed. The Committee therefore enquired from the Ministry of Finance what the Ministry was doing to resolve the issue.

In response, the Minister for Finance, Hon. Ken Ofori-Atta explained to the Committee that the Ministry of Finance is exploring options with SSNIT to provide the necessary liquidity to enable SSNIT meet the "past credit" payments.

#### 5.7 Total Debt

On the size of the national debt, the Committee was informed that as at the end of August 2020, Total National Debt stood at GH¢267.7 Billion, representing 69.7% of GDP.

It was explained to the Committee that this figure differs from the 76.6% of GDP figure published by the International Monetary Fund (IMF) because the IMF had projected the debt figure to the end of 2020 and also included non-central government liabilities which are usually not included in national debt computations.

#### 6.0 <u>CONCLUSION</u>


The Committee respectfully recommends to the House to *adopt* this report and *approve* by Resolution, the sum of *Twenty-Seven Billion*, *Four Hundred and Thirty-Four Million*, *One Hundred and Eighty Thousand*, *Five Hundred and Twenty Ghana Cedis* (GH¢27,434,180,520.00) as Expenditure in Advance of Appropriation for January to March 2021 for the purpose of meeting expenditure necessary to carry on the services of Government for the period January to March, 2021 in accordance with Article 180 of the 1992 Constitution of the Republic of Ghana, the Public Financial Management Act, 2016 (Act 921) and the Standing Orders of the House.


