

**EXECUTIVE INSTRUMENT**

**E.I. 34**

**CORONERS AUTOPSY AND EXHUMATION (FEES)  
INSTRUMENT, 2002**

IN exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister responsible for Justice by subsection (1) of section 22 of the Coroners Act, 1960 (Act 18), this Instrument is made this 15th day of November, 2002.

**Fees payable**

1. The fees specified in column 3 of the Schedule to this Instrument shall be paid to the registered medical practitioner or other qualified person specified in column 2 in the Schedule in respect of the services specified in column 1 of the Schedule in relation to them.

**E.I. 1 of 1998 revoked**

2. The Coroners Autopsy (Fees) Instrument, 1998 (E.I. 1) is revoked.
