- (2) THE TARKWA-AGONA NKWANTA ROAD PROJECT (66.0KM)

1.0 ACTION REQUIRED

- 1.1 Hon. Members of Parliament are respectfully requested to consider and approve the request for the waiver of taxes and duties specifically, Import Duties, Import NHIL, Import VAT, GETFund Levy, EXIM Levy, Special Import Levy and Covid-19 Health Recovery Levy amounting to a total cedi equivalent of €14,704,154.00 on materials/goods and equipment to be imported for:
- (a) the Reconstruction of the Bechem-Techimantia-Akumadan Road Project (40.4km); and
- (b) the Reconstruction of the Tarkwa-Agona Nkwanta Road Project(66.0km) by Messrs. Gabriel Couto-Rango Consortium.
- 1.2 H. E. The President on July 20, 2022 granted Executive approval for the request for tax exemption to enable Parliament consider and approve same.

2.0 BACKGROUND TO THE PROJECT

- 2.1 Parliament, at the Forty-Third Sitting of the Second Meeting held on Wednesday, July, 29 and at the Forty-Fourth Sitting of the Second Meeting held on Thursday, July 30, 2020 respectively, approved by resolution, the following agreements:
 - (a) the Term Loan Facility Agreement between the Government of Ghana (represented by the Ministry of Finance) and Deutsche Bank AG, Frankfurt Branch (as Arranger and Original Lender) and TMF Global Services (UK) Limited (as Facility Agent) for an amount of €147,505,734.00 for the Reconstruction of the Bechem-Techimantia-Akumadan(40.4km) and the Tarkwa-Agona Nkwanta (66.0km) Road Projects; and
- (b) the Design-Build Contract between the Government of Ghana (represented by the Ministry of Roads and Highways (represented by the Ghana Highways Authority) and Mesrrs. Gabriel Couto-Rango Consortium for an amount of €50Million for the implementation of the Reconstruction of the Bechem-Techimantia-Akumadan(40.4KMm) and €95Million for the Tarkwa-Agona Nkwanta (66.0km) Road Projects.
- 2.2 The Bechem-Techimantia-Akumadan road runs in the South-North direction from Bechem in the Bono Region through Dwomo and Techimantia all in the same region to Akumadan in the Ashanti Region. The road connects the Bono Region in Akumadan in the Ashanti Region joining the main Kumasi-Techimantia road at Akumadan through the main agricultural towns and villages.
- 2.3 Currently, the proposed 40.4km section to be re-constructed is in an advanced state of deterioration. This has resulted in a very high vehicle operating cost, dust pollution in the settlement areas, road accidents and low utilisation of the main road in terms of traffic volumes. Traffic safety measures such as pedestrian crossings and pavement and road markings and signages, are all absent along this section.



2.4 The Tarkwa-Agona Nkwanta road, also runs in the South-North direction from Agona Nkwanta to Tarkwa through Bonsa and Nsuta all of which have rubber and mineral prospects. The road forms part of the N1 link between Ghana and Cote D'Ivoire as well as other ECOWAS countries. The road also connects to the main roads in the seaport of Takoradi.

3.0 OBJECTIVE OF THE PROJECT

- 3.1 The main objective of the project includes inter alia:
 - To improve road infrastructure;
 - To help reduce cost of transportation of people and goods;

4.0 SCOPE OF PROJECT

- 4.1 The re-construction of the 40.4 km Bechem-Techimantia-Akumadan and 66.0 km Tarkwa-Agona-Nkwanta Road Projects includes the following:
 - Site clearing;
 - Earthworks;
 - Pavement layers including natural gravel layers, asphalt and double bituminous surfacing;
 - Relocation and/or protection of existing services within the road reserve;
 - Access points along the route;
 - Drainage structures; and
 - Provision of road furniture, streetlights, signage, crash barriers, road markings etc.

5.0 JUSTIFICATION FOR GOVERNMENT'S SUPPORT FOR TAX EXEMPTION

- 5.1 Government of Ghana represented by the Ghana Highway Authority (GHA), signed a Commercial Agreement with the contractor, Messrs. Gabriel Couto-Rango Consortium for the Implementation of the project and is thus expected to abide by and satisfy fully, the conditions provided under it.
- 5.2 Under Clause 14.1(b) of the Particular Conditions of Contract which has been amended by the Supplementary Agreement dated April 20, 2022, it is stipulated that 'it is understood that the accepted contract amount excludes taxes and duties. However, the Contractor shall pay all other taxes and fees required to be paid by him under the Contract, and the Contract Price shall not be adjusted for any of these costs, except as stated in sub-clause 13.7 (Adjustment for changes in legislation);

Notwithstanding the provisions stated above and sub-clause 1.13 (Compliance with Laws), all the Contractors equipment, plant, materials and vehicles imported by the Contractor under the Contract, shall be exempted from the payment of import taxes and duties, specifically import Duties, Import GETFund, Import NHIL, Import VAT,



EXIM levy, COVID-19 Levy and Special Import Levy subject to the approval of the Parliament of the Republic of Ghana'.

5.3 Based on the commitment made above, the Government of Ghana acting through the Ministry of Roads and Highways/Ghana Highway Authority is requesting for exemption of taxes, duties and other levies on the items to be imported under the project to ensure its smooth implementation.

6.0 ASSESSMENT OF TAXES, DUTIES AND LEVIES TO BE WAIVED

The Ghana Revenue Authority(GRA), has assessed the quantum of Customs Duty and Taxes payable on the materials/goods and equipment to be imported under the (2) projects at a total cedi equivalent of €14,704,154.00 (Nourteen Million, Seven Hundred and Four Thousand, One Hundred and Fifty-Four Euros) made up of Import Duties, Import VAT, NHIL/GETFund, Exim Levy, Special Import Levy and Covid-19 Health Recovery Levy.

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Contractor under the Contract, shall be exempt from the payment of import taxes and duties, specifically Import duties, Import GETFUND, Import NHIL, Import VAT, EXIM levy, COVID-19 Levy and Special Import Levy) subject to the approval of the Parliament of the Republic of Ghana
