PUBLIC ELECTIONS (DISTRICT ASSEMBLY) REGULATIONS, 1993¹ [C.I. 2]

[(Article 51) (27th September, 1993)]

1. Local government electoral area

The electoral areas specified in the third column of the First Schedule to the Instrument establishing a District Assembly shall be the local government electoral area for the purposes of District Assembly elections.

2. One member for each electoral area

Each electoral area shall be represented by one member in a District Assembly.

3. Agents of candidate

- (1) For the purposes of a local government election, a candidate may appoint one agent to attend at the polling station to witness the poll and the counting of votes.
- (2) A candidate may appoint not more than two agents to attend at the electoral area centre for purposes of collating the votes from the polling stations.

These Regulations have been superseded by the Public Elections (District Assembly) Regulations, 1993 (C.I. 4).

4. Submission of member's name to the District Chief Executive

After a candidate has been elected as a member of a District Assembly, the Commission shall forward the name of the candidate to the District Chief Executive of the district concerned.

5. Application of L. I. 1537²

Except as otherwise provided in this Instrument, the Public Elections Regulations, 1996 (C.I. 15.) shall apply to local government elections with the necessary modifications made by the Commission.

6. Revocation

7. Interpretation

In this Regulation, unless the context otherwise requires,

"Commission" means the Electoral Commission established by article 43 of the Constitution;

"District Assembly" includes a Municipal or Metropolitan Assembly.
