

**SECOND SESSION OF PARLIAMENT (COMMENCEMENT) INSTRUMENT,
1993**

KNOW YE ALL MEN that in the exercise of the powers conferred on the Speaker by clause (1) of article 112 of the Constitution, I DANIEL FRANCIS ANNAN, Speaker of Parliament, by this Constitutional Instrument, appoint the Accra International Conference Centre as Parliament House to be the place and ten o'clock in the morning of Thursday, the 6th day of January, 1994, to be the time at which the Second Session of the First Parliament of the Fourth Republic of Ghana shall commence.
