REPORT OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE ON THE REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF CUSTOMS DUTIES, TAXES, VAT & NHIL, GCNET, DESTINATION INSPECTION FEES, EDIF AND ECOWAS LEVIES AMOUNTING TO US\$512,758.00 ON GOODS TO BE PROCURED UNDER THE NORTHERN RURAL GROWTH PROGRAMME (NRGP)

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Request for waiver of Customs Duties, Taxes, VAT & NHIL, GCNet, Destination Inspection Fees, EDIF and ECOWAS Levies amounting to *five hundred and twelve thousand, seven hundred and fifty-eight United States Dollars* (US\$512,758.00) on goods to be procured under the Northern Rural Growth Programme (NRGP) was laid in the House on Tuesday 22nd May, 2012 by the Minister of Finance and Economic Planning, Hon. Dr. Kwabena Duffuor.

Pursuant to Order 169 of the Standing Orders of the House, the Agreement was referred to the Finance Committee for consideration and report.

The Committee met and considered the Agreement with the Deputy Minister of Finance and Economic Planning, Hon. Fifi Kwetey and officials from the Ministry of Finance and Economic

Planning and Ghana Revenue Authority (GRA) and hereby presents this report to the House pursuant to order 161(1) of the Standing Orders of the House.

2.0 BACKGROUND

Honourable Members would recall that at the Thirty-Fourth Sitting of Parliament held on Wednesday 16th July 2008, Parliament approved by resolution, the Loan Agreement between the Government of Ghana and the African Development Fund for an amount of forty million Units of Account (UA 40,000,000) [equivalent to US\$60,000,000) to support the Northern Rural Growth Programme (NRGP).

The Northern Rural Growth Programme is co-financed by the African Development Bank (AfDB) and the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD). The total cost programme, excluding taxes and duties, but including physical and price contingencies, is estimated at UA68.38 [equivalent to US\$103.5 million]. In addition to the AfDB Loan, IFAD is providing an amount of US\$22.33 million, Government of Ghana is also providing a counterpart funding and taxes of US\$10.37 whilst Participating million Financial Institutions, beneficiaries and private investors also provide US\$9.24 million.

The overall goal of the Northern Rural Growth Programme (NRGP) is to contribute to equitable and sustainable poverty reduction and food security among rural households. The specific objective is to increase rural household incomes on a sustainable basis in Northern Ghana.

3.0 TOTAL WAIVER REQUESTED

The total amount of taxes and duties for which waiver is being sought is five hundred and twelve thousand, seven hundred and fifty-eight United States Dollars (US\$512,758.00).

4.0 OBSERVATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee observed that the NRGP is the main instrument for integrating and consolidating the various Africa Development Fund investments in Northern Ghana (i.e. the livestock development project, the cashew development project and the small scale irrigation development project) and operationalizing the emerging agriculture sector-wide programme approach.

Synergies and complementarities with on-going projects and programmes is in the fields of capacity building for the agricultural sector, public-private and community based institutions, adaptive research, extension, access to credit and equipment, establishing outgrowers' schemes for industrial crops, fruits and vegetables, production and marketing infrastructure development, and providing support in all aspects of agricultural production, processing and marketing, as well as supporting producers in accessing international markets (certification, traceability).

The Committee noted that article 57 of the Agreement Establishing the African Development Bank requires that the facility granted by the bank and its operation shall not be subject to tax.

It was observed that the NRGP covers all districts located in the three (3) Northern Regions, namely the Northern, Upper East and Upper West Regions as well as five districts in the Brong Ahafo Region which share boundaries with the Northern Region. These five districts are Kintampo North, Kintampo South, Sene, Pru and Tain.

The programme area has a combined population of about three million, more than 70% of which is engaged in subsistence agriculture.

Achievements of the Programme which was officially launched in April 2009 include the following:

- 1,962 small holder farmer groups (making up of 25,316 males and 8,221 females) have been formed and registered with the programme. Those groups have been trained in basic group dynamics and management. These groups have been prepared and linked to Participating Financial Institutions (PFIs) for support.
- 837 small holder groups representing 16,000 households have been successfully linked to financial institutions and have received various financial services to the tune of GH¢1,285,868.00 to support their farm and other business operations.
- 6,906.48 hectares of maize, soya and sorghum have been cultivated since programme inception. Yields have so far improved from 0.6mt/ha to about 1.4mt/ha.
- Two Special Purpose Vehicles (basically associations of rural farmers made of commercial/lead farmers and smallholder/outgrower farmers) have been formed and

supported with the matching grant of the programme to procure 2 tractors. These SPVs have a common purpose to produce an agricultural commodity to sell in commercial quantities and at competitive prices to ensure profitability and therefore sustainability of the ventures.

- Under infrastructure and irrigation development, 150 water pumping machines have been procured and distributed to farmers for use on water bodies for irrigation. Beneficiary farmers are now able to crop three (3) times in a year.
- 154km of feeder roads have been awarded on contract and are at various stages of completion. 492km have been advertised for construction this year. These feeder roads are expected to open up agricultural areas to marketing centers.
- The Programme has successfully engaged the participation of 24 Rural and Community Banks in financing the various value chains of the programme. This is due to the innovative financing model: *Cashless Credit Model* introduced by the Programme. As a result of the model, financial support to farmer groups increased from GH¢24,931.51 in 2009 to GH¢205,177 in 2010 and further to GH¢1,055,759.50 in 2011.

The Committee expressed concern about the value of some of the items to be imported upon which the tax is assessed for waiver. Members therefore strongly recommend to the Ghana Revenue Authority to scrutinize importers' documents thoroughly in assessing their tax liability, especially when such assessment is to be presented to Parliament for waiver and that the Ministry ensures that Parliamentary Resolutions submitted by importers are accompanied by Tax Assessment conducted by the Ghana

Revenue Authority (GRA) for verification before goods are allowed to be cleared.

As a matter of broad policy, the Committee also recommends to the Ministry of Finance and Economic Planning to re-examine and review the tax waiver processes to help secure optimum revenue for the country.

5.0 CONCLUSION

The Committee is satisfied that the request is in consonance with the Loan Agreement already approved by the House between the Government of Ghana and the African Development Fund for an amount of forty million Units of Account (UA 40,000,000) [equivalent to US\$60,000,000) to support the Northern Rural Growth Programme (NRGP).


